Taormina, from atop Mount Tauro, looks over the Bay of Naxos, the first Greek colony in Sicily, founded in 735 b.C. The magnificent Mediterranean-blue bay with active volcano Mount Etna in the background offer a spectacular view from almost everywhere in town. **Taormina** is famous for its beauty, its incredible heritage, history, archaeology and architecture, as well as for its reputation in welcoming travellers. Taormina is perfectly situated to offer students easy access to the **beautiful and historically important treasures of Sicily.**

Our courses and programs are held at “Casa Silva”, an historic villa, built in 1817 just 200 metres away from the Greek Theatre: an architectural, natural and historical treasure that Taormina has miraculously managed to conserve

Our Center for Italian Studies also host several **U.S. Universities programs** for both **Graduate & Undergraduate students**. We offer short-term programs (**winter and summer programs**) and long-term programs (semester programs). Students can directly transfer academic credits and earn undergraduate or graduate credits for all our courses.
