Subject: Scholarship for Italian Advanced Placement Exams Students

My name is Chiara Avidano and I am the Director of Studies at Ciaoltaly in Turin, Italy. In order to promote the study of the Italian language and culture throughout the world I am pleased to offer a scholarship to one student for the year 2021.

This scholarship will cover 100% of the cost of a **three-week intensive group course** (60 hours), learning materials and accommodation in a **shared flat** (single room) or in a **student dorm** (single room) for the same period.

Scholarship details

- Period: 3 weeks (dates to be agreed)
- Level of Italian; to be confirmed
- Type of course: intensive group course, 4 hours a day for 5 days a week (Monday Friday)
- Arrival date: to be agreed
- Departure day: to be agreed
- Minimum age: 18 years old
- Accommodation: the accommodation will be chosen by the school according to the availability in the required period.

School information

Situated in one of Turin's most elegant areas, just a short walk from the Polytechnic, Ciaoltaly specialises in teaching the Italian language and culture to students from all over the world. Ciaoltaly is affiliated to ASILS, AIL, Eduitalia and recognised by the German Bildungsurlaub and CSN Lund-Sweden. The school also offers a Masters in Italian Language Didactics for newly qualified teachers. The institute is an authorised examination centre of the University for Foreigners of Siena for CILS official certifications and for the AIL certification.





Lessons are entrusted to highly qualified teachers who, through the use of a wide range of materials and techniques, enable students to enhance their linguistic skills in a cheerful and friendly environment.

Supervised by staff who speak the main European and Asian languages, students never run the risk of feeling isolated, and they are also given assistance which includes helping them find accommodation during their stay. Moreover, the school proposes numerous recreational activities which allow students to get to know the Torinese people, the city and its surroundings.
