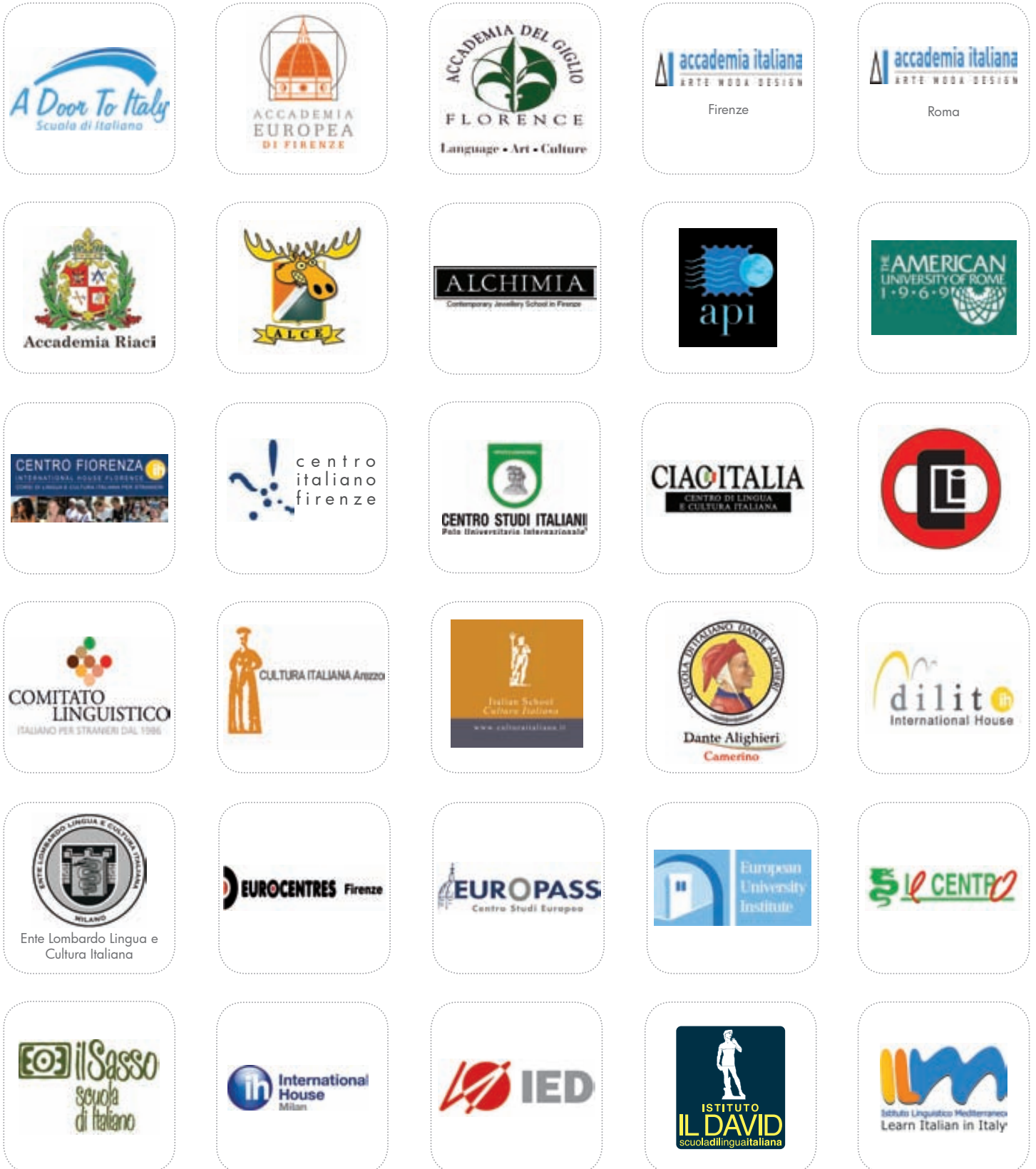

## PIEMONTE
